CIVIL WEDDING CEREMONIES.

As soon as you have made provisional arrangements for your wedding at Arora Hotel Manchester, you should contact the Superintendent of Registrars in Manchester on +44 (0)161 234 5531 to check on their availability and to make an advance booking.

A fee for the Registrar will be payable to the Superintendent of Registrars before the Ceremony. You will also have to give notice of marriage to the Superintendent of Registrars in the district in which you live. This notice must be given in person and is valid for one year. If you live in a different area to the one in which you are getting married, you will have to collect the authority before the Wedding Day and deliver it to Manchester Superintendent of Registrars.

The Superintendent of Registrars can perform only non-religious ceremonies. Any music, readings, words or performances that form any part of the ceremony must be secular. Therefore the Superintendent of Registrars must agree the content in advance of the Ceremony.
